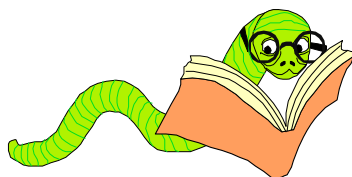

Dear Friends,

We're proud to announce that the **2009 Culver City Reads** choice for summer reading is the Pippi Longstocking books and the most recent movie adaptation, *The New Adventures of Pippi Longstocking*. Astrid Lindgren wrote the first Pippi book in 1944 when her young daughter was ill and in need of cheering up. Later, Lindgren submitted the manuscript to a Swedish publisher who turned it down; he's still kicking himself over one of the worst decisions in publishing history. Pippi immediately became a worldwide phenomenon, read and enjoyed by children in dozens of languages.

To celebrate her 65th birthday, we're throwing Pippi an after-hours party at the library on July 18. Those of you who came to our Stuart Little event at the library last summer know that it was a great way to have fun and share enjoyment of books and movies in the Heart of Screenland. This year's going to be even bigger and better. Read the local papers for games and contests leading up to Pippi's party. And the library has ordered extra copies of Pippi books for the summer, so why not pick one up and visit with an old friend? You'll be delighted to discover she's just as fresh and funny as when you were a kid.

On a less happy note, the recent budget cuts have forced the County to stop funding the licensing agreement that allows libraries to screen movies. The Friends have agreed to pay the licensing fees for the next year and these very popular events will continue at our library with even better and more recent movie titles. This would not have been possible without your continuing support. As always, your generosity is sincerely appreciated.

County Library Programs:

Summer Reading Program for Children will kick off on Wed, July 1 at 2pm and will continue all summer long every Wednesday at 2pm through August 19. The theme for the Summer Reading Program this year is Be Creative @ Your Library. On the final day, August 19, there will be special plays in celebration of Fiesta La Ballona. The bicycle drawing will also be that day. While the We Tell Stories plays are designed for young school age children, preschoolers are welcome to attend and many do. They really enjoy watching the older children perform in the plays. There is no registration required to attend these programs.

Enjoy the interactive plays of the storytelling troupe "We Tell Stories" Wednesdays at 2 p.m., July 1st through August 19th. (All performances are made possible in part by the Culver City Performing Arts Grant Program with support from Sony Pictures Entertainment.) July 1st is also the first day to sign up for the reading-based portion of the Summer Reading Program. This includes both children who read and children who are being read to. Bedtime Storytime Tuesday at 7 pm, for preschool to 8 year old (babies and toddlers are also welcome!) No registration required for this storytime.

Toddler Storytime summer session for children under 3 years of age will be Mondays and Wednesdays at 10 am. starting 6/29-8/19. Pre-registration is required and will take place on Monday, 6/22 @ 10 a.m. Classes are limited to 25 children, first come, first served.

Preschool Storytime summer session for children aged 3-5 years of age will be on Wednesdays at 11:00 a.m. starting Wed. 7/1-8/19. **Pre-registration is required** and will begin on Mon. 6/22 at 10:00 a.m. Class size is limited to 45 children so it does not fill up as quickly as the Toddler Storytime.
