Bylaws Amendments

The Executive Board has approved the amending organization's bylaws. Consistent with the existing bylaws, amendments may be adopted by a majority vote at any meeting provided that members have been informed of the proposed changes in the notice of the meeting. Please accept this announcement as notice of the Annual Membership Meeting/Installation Dinner to be held on January 11, 2011 at 6:00 p.m. where the proposed bylaws amendments will be voted on. A copy of the proposed bylaws amendment is also available for the memberships' review on our website (www.ccfol.org) and available to review at the Reference Desk at the Library.

The By-Law change is to Article IV – Officers Section 2. Nominations subsection a. Nominations for officers shall be solicited in the Newsletter or by special letter and shall be mailed or sent by electronic mail at least thirty (30) days prior to the November Executive Board meeting. The change is inserting the underlined and bolded phrase. The same change is to be made to Article VI – Executive Board Section 2. Nominations subsection a. where the same phrase would be inserted in the first sentence.
