The Culver City Friends of the Library invite you to participate in *Culver City Reads*, a community-wide reading fest to promote reading, education and literacy. The program encourages people of all ages to read the same book. The book selected for this year is "Peter Pan," the timeless story of adventure and magic by J.M. Barrie. Throughout the next several months, the Friends will hold a series of events and activities revolving around Peter Pan designed to show children and adults alike how books come alive. The program will culminate in an "under the stars" screening of a popular Peter Pan movie at Veterans Park on Saturday, August 19, 2006!

The Essay Contest

One of the *Culver City Reads* activities is a "Why I Want To Grow Up In Culver City" essay contest. In 300 words or less, please tell us "**Why You Want To Grow Up In Culver City.**" Your essay can include why you like living, working, going to school, shopping, dining, and/or just having fun in Culver City.

There are five entry categories: 1) children grades 4-6 (school year 2006/2007); 2) children grades 7-9 (school year 2006-2007); 3) children grades 10-12 (school year 2006/2007); 4) adults (ages 18-54); and 5) seniors (age 55 and above). Six winners will be selected – one in each of the five entry categories and an overall winner for "Best Essay" – and awards will be announced and presented at the Fiesta La Ballona in Veterans Park on August 26 and 27, 2006 (exact date and time of award presentation to be determined). The "Best Essay" will be **published in the Culver City News**, a major sponsor of *Culver City Reads*.

Contest Entry Rules

- 1. You must be a member of the Culver City Friends of the Library or hold a County of Los Angeles Public Library Card to be eligible to enter the contest. You may pick up a membership application at the Culver City Julian Dixon Library. Student membership (under 18 years of age) in the Friends of the Library is \$5.00; Individual membership is \$10.00; Senior membership (over 55 years of age) is \$5.00; a County of Los Angeles Public Library Card is FREE.
- 2. Each contestant must complete and sign the Entry Form and attach his/her essay. For children under 18 years of age, the Entry Form must be signed by a parent or guardian indicating his/her approval.
- 3. All essays must be submitted on an 8.5" x 11" piece of paper. Be sure to print name and phone number on the back of the paper.
- 4. Each contestant may submit only one entry. If more than one entry is received, the contestant will be disqualified.
- 5. Entries must be submitted to the Culver City Friends of the Library and reach us no later than July 21, 2006. Entries will not be accepted and cannot be modified after that date.
- 6. Entries will not be returned under any circumstances.
